1. Welcome to Guru (Bosch)

2. Welcome to Phani (ZettaScale)

Frédéric Desbiens introduced Phani Gangula, ZettaScale's new main representative on the steering committee. Phani is based in Germany and is a senior solution architect at the company.

3. Adopt the minutes of the November 27, 2023, call

The committee approved the minutes unanimously.

4. Virtual IoT and Edge Days (May 2024)

Frédéric Desbiens announced to the committee that the Foundation will once again organize its Virtual IoT and Edge Days virtual event in May. The event will take place on May 8-9, 2024, and take roughly the same form as in 2023.

There will be a public CFP. More details will follow.

5. Eclipse Edge Native Special Interest Group status

Frédéric Desbiens shared with the committee his concern about the state of the Edge Native special interest group. The monthly meetings attract only a handful of participants and there are no concrete activities happening.

The committee discussed this state of affairs. At the end of the discussion, Frédéric stated he would reach out directly to reliable people at the member organizations to ensure they show up at the next meeting.

6. Eclipse ThreadX progress update

Frédéric Desbiens informed the committee about the progress of the upcoming ThreadX working group. There are now a draft charter and participation agreement available. The Foundation expects the working group to launch in late March or early April.

Frédéric invited the committee member organizations to join the ThreadX interest group, where discussions about the working group happen, if they wish to influence the upcoming working group. Participation is free, and does not represent a commitment to join the working group later.

Frédéric added that one of his personal goals is to make sure zenoh and Sparkplug are first-class citizens of the ThreadX ecosystem.
