1. Welcome to Guru (Bosch)

Frédéric welcomed Dr. Guru Prasad, Bosch's new main representative to the Eclipse IoT steering committee.

2. Adopt the minutes of the January 22, 2024, call

3. Eclipse IoT steering committee chair

Frédéric Desbiens reminded the members of the committee that, according to the [Eclipse Working Group Operation's Guide](#), Working Group committees, including the steering committee, must elect a chair among their members.

The position of Eclipse IoT chair is currently vacant. This vacancy must be filled. Frédéric invited the members of the committee to self-nominate by sending an email to the steering committee mailing list. If there are more than one candidate, then an election will take place.

4. Eclipse Edge Native Special Interest Group status

Frédéric Desbiens updated the committee on the status of the Edge Native Special Interest Group. Participation to the last meeting was good, and he asked the community members on the call to come prepared to the next meeting. The intent is to discuss initiative ideas that could reenergise the SIG and give it a renewed focus.

Frédéric added that the position of SIG chair is also vacant. He incited the members of the steering committee to identify potential chairs in the ranks of their respective organisations.
