1. Adopt the minutes of the April 22, 2024, call

The minutes were not distributed in time; they will be adopted at the next meeting.

2. Marketing update

Amin Rasti updated the committee about recent marketing activities. The recent webinars broadcast on May 8 and 9 drew less viewers than expected, due to public holidays in Europe. We will take this into account for future events. The call for proposals for the Open Community Experience (OCX) conference is open. The early bird deadline is May 31 and the final deadline June 10, 2024.

3. Eclipse IoT steering committee chair

Frédéric Desbiens reminded committee members that the steering committee needs to select a chair among its members.

4. Eclipse Edge Native Special Interest Group status

Frédéric Desbiens summarised the discussions held at the last meeting of the Edge Native SIG. The consensus of the participants was that terminating the SIG was the only way forward. Edge Native topics can still be discussed at regular Eclipse IoT Community meetings.

Robert Andres noted that changing the working group's name to "Eclipse IoT and Edge" would convey that the group still cares about Edge Computing.

5. VOTE: Eclipse Edge Native SIG termination

This vote was pushed to the next meeting since there were only half of the delegates present.

6. Community meeting at Open Community Experience

Matteo Maiero expressed concern about the lack of a dedicated community day at the upcoming OCX conference. Robert Andres added that justifying the participation of Eurotech staff members to the event was more difficult in the absence of a proper gathering of Eclipse IoT committers.

Frédéric Desbiens committed to organise a session for the Eclipse IoT community at the event.

7. GitHub changes

Matteo Maiero shared feedback about an upcoming change to Eclipse-owned organisations on GitHub. He stated that this change could impact the visibility and credibility of the Eclipse Kura and Eclipse Kapua projects.

Frédéric Desbiens noted he was not aware of the change and would try to understand the situation better.
