Minutes:

1. Marketing update

Thea Aldrich updated the committee members on current marketing activities.

Right now, the main focus is on the 2025 Embedded and IoT developer survey report. The Foundation's team aims to publish it in December. Robert Andres asked whether he could get a copy of the raw data. Thea replied she would do so at her earliest convenience, since getting access to such data is a privilege enjoyed by leader members of the working group.

From an events perspective, the working group will focus on Embedded World and Open Community Experience (OCX) for the first half of 2026. Thea invited the delegates to make sure their colleagues submit technical talks to OCX. The deadline to do so is November 14, 2025.

2. 2026 Eclipse IoT Program Plan

Frédéric Desbiens moderated a discussion on the draft program plan. Small adjustments were discussed and made to the deck.
