**Minutes:**

**1. Adopt the minutes of the October 27, 2025, call**

The minutes were adopted unanimously.

**2. Project and industry news updates**

Frédéric Desbiens shared news about Eclipse ThreadX and the activities of the OpenHW Foundation with the delegates. Improving RISC-V support is an important objective for the ThreadX project. On the other hand, the open source RISC-V cores built by the OpenHW community need proper software support to gain traction in the market. Frédéric is working with both communities to make sure that they coordinate their efforts.

**3. Marketing update**

Thea Aldrich updated the delegates about current and future marketing activities. The annual Embedded and IoT Developer survey will likely be published in January 2026 to maximise its impact. Embedded World 2026, which will take place in March, will be a focal point for the working group's promotion in the first half of the year.

**4. 2026 Eclipse IoT Financial Plan**

Frédéric Desbiens shared the 2026 financial plan proposal with the delegates. He reminded them that the Eclipse Foundation is the fiduciary for the working group membership fees and, as such, is the entity accountable for the money allocated to Eclipse IoT. Thus, the steering committee is not adopting a budget in the standard business sense, but rather acknowledging that the financial plan proposal provides the working group with the financial support needed to achieve the goals highlighted in the program plan.

The 2026 proposal is similar to the 2025 version, as membership has been stable during the last 12 months.

**5. VOTE: Acknowledgement of the 2026 Eclipse IoT Financial Plan**

Frédéric Desbiens put forward the following motion for a nominal vote:

*RESOLVED, the Steering Committee approves the 2026 Financial Plan as presented, acknowledging the allocations match the Program Plan to the extent possible based on projected revenue.*

The motion was adopted unanimously by the delegates in attendance.
