Minutes:

1. Minutes Adoption

The minutes from the January 26, 2026, call were reviewed and officially adopted by the committee.

2. Refreshing the Adopters Process

The committee discussed the need to make the adopter listing process less "tech-heavy." Currently, requiring a GitHub issue or Pull Request is a barrier for marketing-oriented people at adopter companies. Ignacio volunteered to act as a bridge, allowing adopters to email him directly with project names, logos, and website info to help speed up the listing of at least 9 adopters by each Leader member. He is also looking into a simplified web contact form to automate this. Robert confirmed that one new major adopter for Kura and Kapua has been added, with another potential large US cement company in the pipeline. Ignacio is to draft and send an email to the SC that they can forward to potential adopters, explaining the simplified, interim process.

3. Restructuring Community Meetings

There is a consensus that the Monthly Community calls need more "life" and a wider audience. The current attendance is mostly limited to a few organisations. The plan is to move from just "status updates" to highlighting use cases, success stories, and new projects. Thea will provide content planning templates and a Google Drive folder to organise speakers in advance. Outreach to Gen Z developers and university students was identified as a priority, potentially including a \$500-\$1,000 reimbursement program for student-led meetups. For the next call in March, Ignacio will invite Anastasios Zafeiropoulos (NTU Athens) to introduce the new Eclipse VOStack project.

The committee also identified the launch of a quarterly series of webinars as a powerful tool to

amplify project visibility and provide a more structured platform for spreading the word about community successes.

4. Marketing Update: EW and OCX

For Embedded World (EW), Eurotech will be featured in the Eclipse booth, and a major press release is scheduled for March 3rd, prominently featuring Eclipse IoT. Regarding OCX in April, the committee is eager to participate in a BoF, with Ignacio and Thea leading the coordination. A decision on the session format is needed in the coming days to secure room resources. Additional potential projects and speakers were identified by Ignacio, who will be targeting them in the next few days, and also extending the message to the wider community during the Monthly Call on February, 24. Additionally, the RISC-V Summit Europe CFP deadline is March 2nd, and the membership prospectus is undergoing a light design refresh via consultants.

5. New Project: Eclipse VOStack

The project was proposed on Feb 4th and has cleared the Community Review period. It is expected to go live next week. As noted above, the Project Lead will likely introduce the technical scope during the next Community call and likely at OCX.

6. Edge-Cloud Project Matrices

Ignacio proposed updating the current architectural graphics on the website to include newer projects. Robert cautioned that these graphics were originally part of a highly successful Edge Native White Paper (2,000+ downloads) and suggested the text/context of that paper be updated alongside the graphics so the images don't lose their explanatory value.

7. IoT Secure Boot Research Survey

The survey from the University of Bristol regarding secure booting will be promoted via LinkedIn and email to the community. Robert expressed Eurotech's interest in a follow-up interview with the researchers to dive deeper into the outcomes. Ignacio will connect Andy with the Eurotech team once the initial survey promotion begins.

8. Any Other Business (AOB)

The PAC White Paper is expected to be delivered this Wednesday. Thea to review and prepare for amplification.
